## LIDA®

According to OSHA Regulation, the precious metal coating and the substrate to which it is applied constitute an Article. An "Article" is specifically excluded from the scope of the Hazard Communication Rule. ("Article" is defined as being a manufactured item which is formed with specific shape or design during manufacture which has end-use function dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end-use and which does not release or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use.) As such, no MSDS would be required for sale of coated substrates. Moreover, please note that the coating is non-toxic, non-hazardous, and for all practical purposes, inert.
